

# COVID-19:

## Camp F&G Policies & Protocols

Updated as of Spring 2022



**The following are based on the premise of keeping the community spread of COVID-19 under control.**

**At Camp F&G, we will be following all of the guidelines & recommendations set forth by the CDC and by the State of NJ.**

**Camp F&G will not adopt any practices less restrictive than the State of New Jersey and the CDC and may be more restrictive, based on the conditions we believe to be in the best interest of the health of our entire Camp Family, for both campers & staff.**

**\*All Covid-19 Policies & Protocols are subject to change, at any time, due to the constantly evolving & changing nature of the Covid-19 Pandemic.\***

### WHILE ATTENDING CAMP:

- **Whenever possible, Camp Activities will be held Outside.**  
*In the case of inclement weather, the indoor clubhouse will be used.*
- **Outdoor masking is optional.\*** (*\*subject to change based on the most up to date recommendations & requirements of the local DOH & CDC\**) Indoor masking, is strongly encouraged & if local case numbers are high, indoor masking may become required.
- **Hand Sanitizer must be used upon arrival.**
- **We ask that every person does a health screening of their child on their own, every morning, before Camp to ensure:**
  - **Your child has NO symptoms (as listed by the CDC)**
  - **No one in your home is suspected of having or have been diagnosed with Covid-19 in the last 30 days**
  - **In the last 14 days, you have NOT come into contact with anyone suspected to have or diagnosed with Covid-19.**
- **You and your family are expected to comply with any State of NJ's Self-Quarantine Requirement as related to any travel inside &/or outside of the country.**
- **Handwashing & hand sanitizing stations will be readily available throughout the entire facility & used often.**
- **Cleaning, sanitizing & disinfecting will occur at the beginning of the Camp day, during the Camp day and at the end of the Camp day.**
- **Visitors to Camp will be limited to vaccinated individuals.**
- **Staff & CITs are required to have their Covid-19 vaccination & booster.** \*Campers are STRONGLY recommended to have their Covid-19 vaccine & any eligible booster as well.

*(\*subject to change to required based on the most up to date recommendations & requirements of the local DOH & CDC at the time of Summer\*)*

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. As a result, federal, state, and local governments and federal and state health agencies recommend masking and social distancing.

Camp Fish & Game has put in place extensive preventative measures such as: primarily outdoor Camp activities, vaccinated staff, handwashing & hand sanitizing throughout the day, extensive cleaning protocols before, during & after camp, indoor masking when local cases are high and more, in order to reduce the spread of COVID-19; however, Camp Fish & Game cannot guarantee that you or your child(ren) will not become infected with COVID-19.
